## Transport

Trondheim airport is named Vaernes and is located 40 km outside city. Directs flights from Amsterdam (KLM) and Copenhagen (SAS). Usually we travel via OSLO. The distance Trondheim-Oslo is operated by SAS ([www.sasbraathen.no](http://www.sasbraathen.no)) and by Norwegian ([www.norwegian.no](http://www.norwegian.no)). They both use same types of planes and it is connections roughly once an hour. Early booking is essential for low fare.

Buses to town leave from right outside the main terminal building (arrival). They run VERY often (approximately every 15 minutes) and in conjunction with the arrival of each flight. You buy tickets on the bus (90 NOK ~10 EUR), cash or by credit card. The trip to Trondheim takes approximately 40 minutes. Besides the bus stops just outside the town center, the bus stops at nearly all hotels, also at Hotel Augustin at the corner of Kongens gt and Prinsen's gt

If you are going to the airport from town and need the schedule, you will find it on <http://www.klaburuten.no/> Click on FLYBUSSEN. The schedule is in Norwegian. Essentially the buses run Monday-Friday and Sunday (mandag-fredag and søndag) : 4 times an hour ; Saturday (lørdag): 2 times an hour.

(Note: A taxi from the airport will cost about 600 NOK and is not necessary.)

You can use the airport bus ticket as a transfer to the local buses in Trondheim (i.e. within an hour you do NOT have to pay twice).

26.-27. March 2009

Local transport from City Hotels to campus Gløshaugen:

- By foot, 20 – 25 min (recommended)
- By Bus no 5, NOK 30, every 10-15 min, takes about 7 min, leaves from Dronningensgate and bus stop right outside PFI (the meeting place).
- By taxi, 5-7 min, should be less than 100 NOK.

## **Miscellaneous**

In Norway the currency is Norwegian Kroner (NOK). In general it is possible to pay everywhere using a debit (VISA) or credit card. In cash you will have to pay in NOK. The current exchange rate (January 2009) is about: NOK 9.50 = EUR 1.

NTNU will arrange coffee breaks, two lunches and a dinner on Thursday and all participants will be charged 60 EUR in cash at registration to cover the expenses.
